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Dr.K.Sridharan, Principal, J.K.K.Munirajah College of Technology welcomed the Members of Board of Studies for the Department of Mechanical And Automobilein the First Meeting. The Chairman of Board Mr.K.Sriram, Head, Department of MechanicalEngineering, J.K.K.Munirajah College of Technology introduced the internal members to Committee and presented the draft syllabus to the committee members

The Meeting proceeded to the matters in Agenda:

S.NO	POINTS DISCUSSED
1	Dr. E. Porpatham mentioned that the third semester's curriculum is difficult for students. He suggested reviewing the course content and subject distribution.
2	Dr. M. Raja proposed moving "Engineering Mechanics" to the second semester since it's a fundamental subject.
3	Dr. M. Raja emphasized that the names of subjects and their corresponding labs should be consistent to avoid confusion.
4	Dr. P. T. Saravanakumar suggested moving the internship program to the fifth semester to give students more practical experience and time to apply their theoretical knowledge.
-5	The BOS committee discussed combining some of the elective courses to streamline the options available to students. This would help simplify the decision-making process for students and ensure they have access to relevant and valuable courses.
6	The inclusion of open electives from other departments was discussed to provide students with interdisciplinary exposure.
7 .	The committee discussed adding core subjects from the Automobile Engineering stream to the curriculum to enhance students' knowledge in mechanical and automobile fields.
8	Concerns were raised about the low weightage assigned to certain subjects in the fifth semester. It was decided to re-evaluate this to ensure a balanced curriculum.



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9	The curriculum will be revised based on the discussions, including relocating "Engineering Mechanics" to the second semester and adjusting the weightage of fifth-semester subjects.
10	Internship programs will be scheduled for the fifth semester, as decided during the meeting. This timing allows students to benefit from practical experiences after gaining sufficient theoretical knowledge
11	The panel members suggested ensuring that the names of subjects and their corresponding lab courses are consistent. This change aims to reduce confusion and improve clarity for students.
12	Open electives from other departments will be introduced to the curriculum, providing students with opportunities to explore various fields and broaden their academic experience.
13	Core subjects from the Automobile Engineering stream will be integrated into the curriculum to expand students' expertise in this area, complementing their mechanical engineering knowledge.
14	Dr. M. Raja suggested including a management course in the curriculum. This course would help students develop essential management skills, which are valuable in the professional world.
15	Dr. P. T. Saravanakumar recommended that the curriculum include two textbooks and four reference books with the latest editions. This ensures that students have access to up-to-date and comprehensive resources.
16	Dr. M. Raja emphasized the need to clearly define course outcomes (CO) and program outcomes (PO). Properly defined outcomes help guide the curriculum and ensure that students meet the expected learning objectives.
17	Dr. M. Raja proposed to add one communication skill paper in the curriculum.
18	The BOS committee approved the engineering graphics syllabus.
